DETAILS

On 1-12-11, while working a 9x5 tour as a Detective assigned to the SCPD Identity Theft Unit, undersigned was assisting Detective William Peeker # 1120/3211/1 with an ongoing Identity Theft 1st investigation CC# 11-3976. Undersigned reported to 30 Pitchpine Drive, Medford, NY to assist Det. Peeker as a witness for a victim statement he was attempting to take from Palma Laffer.

Upon arrival at above location, Palma Laffer reported that her son had just confessed to her that he had taken the money from her bank account, after he stole her debit card from her pocketbook. Upon learning this new information, the subject while standing in the kitchen of his home, was verbally identified as David S. Laffer d.o.b. 11-16-77. After identifying the subject, undersigned asked subject if he had any weapons on his person, at which time he replied "no". He was then asked if there were any weapons in the house for which he replied "yes", and stated that there were several handguns and rifles. He stated that they were all registered weapons on pistol permits belonging to himself and to his mother. The victim, Palma Laffer confirmed weapons in the household and pistol permits, at which time David Laffer was asked by undersigned to exit the house and stand on the driveway.

While out on the driveway, at approximately 1150 hrs, a phone call was placed to the SCPD Pistol Licensing Bureau. PO Kelly Smith answered the phone. PO Smith was informed about the details of the identity theft case under investigation, and also informed about the weapons in the home. PO Smith was then told that the victim was choosing not to press charges against her son, and that the subject involved was not going to be arrested. PO Smith confirmed active SCPD Pistol License for both parties, and confirmed listed weapons on each license. PO Smith stated to undersigned that she would inform her supervisor of the nature of our investigation and the incident that took place. PO Smith stated that the weapons could remain in the home, and that the SCPD Pistol Licensing Bureau would follow-up with their own investigation in the future.
